

V. FAMILY AND CONSUMER EDUCATION CONTENT STANDARDS

The following are Standards for Family and Consumer Education Grades 6 – 12:

1. Analyze how the well being of individuals in society is dependent upon the family.
2. Integrate scientific concepts and principles, mathematical processes, practical reasoning, and communication skills as related to family work and careers.
3. Evaluate nutritional wellness practices to promote individual and family well being throughout the life span.
4. Promote optimal growth and development of self, family members, and others throughout the life span.
5. Create respectful and caring relationships in the family workplace and community.
6. Integrate multiple life roles connecting family, career, and community responsibilities.
7. Analyze parenting roles and responsibilities and their impact on strengthening the well being of individuals and families.
8. Analyze the consumer's role in managing human, economic, environmental, and technological resources enabling individuals, families, and communities to achieve self-sufficiency.
9. Develop an awareness and/or explore family and consumer science related careers for further career options.
10. Develop employment competencies in the family and consumer science area.
