**II. Social Studies K-12 Content Standards**

**Content Standard A – Geography:** Students will learn about geography through the study of the relationships among people, places, and environments.

**Content Standard D – Economics:** Students will learn about production, distribution, exchange, and consumption so that they can make informed economic decisions.

**Content Standard E – Behavioral Science:** Students will learn about the behavioral sciences by exploring concepts from the discipline of sociology, the study of the interactions among individuals, groups, and institutions; the discipline of anthropology, the study of cultures in various times and settings.
